Irrigation

Irrigation season is fast approaching. Please be courteous to other users. Tampering with head gates will **NOT** be tolerated. If tampering occurs your water turn will be revoked. Water is estimated to be in the ditch the second week of May. Let's make this year's irrigation season a success!

DOG LICENSES

Please remember that **ALL** dogs 6 months of age or older residing in Corinne City must be licensed. Before they can be licensed, proof of rabies must be presented. A citation will be issued for unlicensed dogs.

All dogs must be contained on their owner's property or on a leash. Any dog found to be at large will be declared a nuisance and will be impounded at the city kennel. A fee will be imposed and the owner will be cited. (Corinne City Code 5-1-4)

Off Highway Vehicles

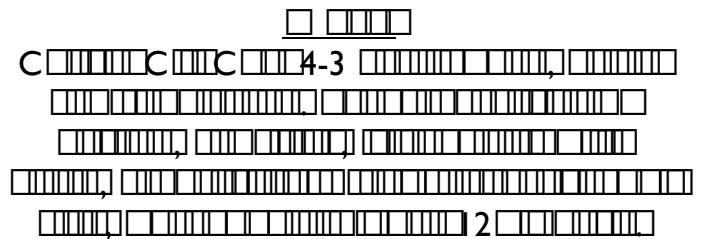
Corinne City Code 6-2 allows the use of OHV on city streets as long as they are: legally registered, you have a valid drivers license, speed and street signs are obeyed and protective headgear is worn by those under 18 years of age. If you are found in violation, a citation will be issued and prosecuted.
